2. You may know that UC lecturers have signed a new agreement with UC, in which, for example, they receive a 7% raise, and a lump sum payment. It had been a question whether this increase was going to be borne by departments (as the increase in grad stipends last year was). But we have gotten word that, preliminarily, the Chancellor's office will fund the lump sum payment and permanently fund the salary increases.
