Dear Graduate Students:

As you know, the gift is allowing us to facilitate graduate research in a variety of ways. We are happy to inform you of a new policy regarding a third summer of fellowship support. The precise details of the policy are below:

The department will provide a third year of summer support for students entering in 2018 or later who have advanced to candidacy, for \$6,000, during one summer of the student's choosing after the fourth year in the program, with the understanding that if the student accepts these funds, the student will do six weeks of full-time research that summer (which may include preparation for the job market) and that the student will be ineligible to TA for the department that summer. For students admitted before 2018, the department will provide a third year of support in the summer after their sixth year, for \$6,000, with the same understanding with respect to responsibilities and ineligibility for summer teaching.

We realize that the gift is generating a lot of new policies lately, which as of now are simply recorded in various emails. We are in the process of updating the graduate manual and will be putting all of these in the updated version of the manual.
